 - o Delaware is administering vaccine to any resident over the age of 16
 - o As of April 11, Delaware has administered 562,730 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine (190,159 are fully vaccinated, and 332,375 have had at least one dose).

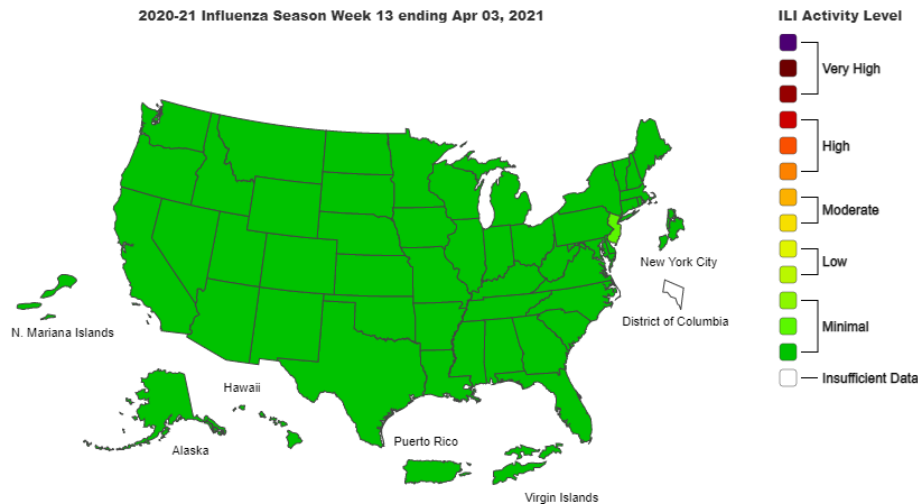


2020-2021 Flu Season

United States

Seasonal influenza activity in the United States remains lower than usual for this time of year. ILI activity levels may be impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and should be interpreted with caution.

- Avian influenza outbreak in [Nigeria](#)
- [Ebola](#)
 - o DRC (12 cases; 6 deaths; CFR 50.0%). As of April 4, there have been no new confirmed cases in North Kivu for 34 consecutive days.
 - o Guinea (23 cases; 12 deaths; CFR 52.2%). The outbreak is largely under control, though is facing community resistance to response measures in the sub-prefecture of Soulouta, where the disease remains active.
