- Hospitalizations: 159, critical: 22
- Delaware Specific COVID-Vaccine Information (de.gov/covidvaccine)
- Delaware Vaccine Release Tracker (<u>MyHealthyCommunity</u>)
 - Delaware is administering vaccine to any resident over the age of 16
 - As of April 18, Delaware has administered 635,825 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine (226,953 are fully vaccinated, and 137,654 have had at least one dose).

United States

- Experimental antiviral for COVID-19 effective in hamster study
- Half of US adults have received at least one COVID-19 shot
- <u>NIH</u>-funded COVID-19 testing initiative aims to safely return children to in-person school
- <u>NIH</u> trial of anti-CD14 antibody to treat COVID-19 respiratory disease begins
- Remote <u>Alaska</u> villages boast high vaccination rates

- <u>Philippines</u> lifts suspension on AstraZeneca vaccine for under 60s




2020-2021 Flu Season

United States

Seasonal influenza activity in the United States remains lower than usual for this time of year. ILI activity levels may be impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and should be interpreted with caution.
