- New Events
- Ongoing Events
 - Cameroon Coronavirus Disease (18,582 cases; 403 deaths; CFR 2.2%). This is the seventh most affected country in the African region: 104 out of 190 districts have been affected. A total of 780 health care workers have been affected.
 - DRC Ebola Virus Disease (2020) (88 cases; 36 deaths; CFR 40.9%).
 Nine additional cases and three new deaths have been reported this week. Ten out of 18 heath zones and 30 out of 281 health areas in

- Equateur Province have reported at least one confirmed or probable case. At least one patient was a confirmed contact, was vaccinated, and was monitored regularly.
- South Africa Coronavirus Disease (587,345 cases; 11,839 deaths; CFR 2.0%). The country continues to have the highest number of cases and deaths on the continent. Daily new cases are steadily declining, but the country has a policy of only testing those symptomatic for the virus. All provinces in the country are affected.
