- Delaware Specific COVID-Vaccine Information (de.gov/covidvaccine)
 - Delaware Vaccine Release Tracker (MyHealthyCommunity)
 - Delaware is currently in Phase 1B of vaccine release
 - As of 1/24/2021, Delaware has administered 67,475 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine
- More than 11,000 receive coronavirus vaccine in Delaware over the weekend (<u>NBC</u>)




2020-2021 Flu Season
