 - o As of July 18, Delaware has administered 1,037,252 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine (461,961 are fully vaccinated (48.3%), and 517,566 (54.1%) have had at least one dose). Of Delawareans over the age of 18, 70.4% have been vaccinated with at least one dose.
 - o Delaware has opened four standalone COVID-19 [vaccination clinics](#), which will serve for the next several months as an option for people to be vaccinated (with or without an appointment). Appointments can be made by calling 1-833-643-1715. Clinics will offer vaccines Monday through Friday from 8:30 – 11:30 am and 1:15 – 4:00 pm.
