- Delaware Specific COVID-Vaccine Information (de.gov/covidvaccine)
- Delaware Vaccine Release Tracker (<u>MyHealthyCommunity</u>)
 - As of July 25, Delaware has administered 1,047,994 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine (466,751 are fully vaccinated (48.8%), and 522,854 (54.6%) have had at least one dose). Of Delawareans over the age of 18, 70.4% have been vaccinated with at least one dose.
 - Delaware has opened four standalone COVID-19 vaccination clinics, which will serve for the next several months as an option for people to be vaccinated (with or without an appointment). Appointments can be made by calling 1-833-643-1715. Clinics will offer vaccines Monday through Friday from 8:30 – 11:30 am and 1:15 – 4:00 pm.
