- Delaware Specific COVID-Vaccine Information (de.gov/covidvaccine)
- Delaware Vaccine Release Tracker (MyHealthyCommunity)
 - As of May 31, Delaware has administered 915,630 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine (385,903 are fully vaccinated (40.3%), and 476,975 (49.8%) have had at least one dose).
 - Delaware has opened four standalone COVID-19 <u>vaccination clinics</u>, which will serve for the next several months as an option for people to be vaccinated (with or without an appointment). Appointments can be made by calling 1-833-643-1715. Clinics will offer vaccines Monday through Friday from 8:30 11:30 am and 1:15 4:00 pm.




2020-2021 Flu Season
