  - o As of May 31, Delaware has administered 915,630 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine (385,903 are fully vaccinated (40.3%), and 476,975 (49.8%) have had at least one dose).
  - o Delaware has opened four standalone COVID-19 [vaccination clinics](#), which will serve for the next several months as an option for people to be vaccinated (with or without an appointment). Appointments can be made by calling 1-833-643-1715. Clinics will offer vaccines Monday through Friday from 8:30 – 11:30 am and 1:15 – 4:00 pm.

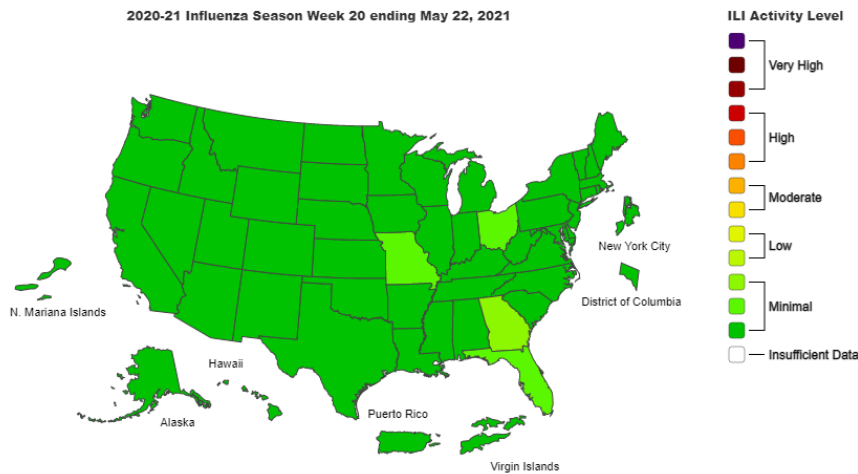


## 2020-2021 Flu Season

#### United States

Seasonal influenza activity in the United States remains lower than usual for this time of year. ILI activity levels may be impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and should be interpreted with caution.

There have been 26 laboratory confirmed cases of influenza in Delaware so far this season.
