- Delaware Specific COVID-Vaccine Information (de.gov/covidvaccine)
- Delaware Vaccine Release Tracker (MyHealthyCommunity)
  - As of June 27, Delaware has administered 1,005,557 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine (444,634 are fully vaccinated (46.4%), and 503,957 (52.6%) have had at least one dose).
  - Delaware has opened four standalone COVID-19 vaccination clinics, which will serve for the next several months as an option for people to be vaccinated (with or without an appointment). Appointments can be made by calling 1-833-643-1715. Clinics will offer vaccines Monday through Friday from 8:30 11:30 am and 1:15 4:00 pm.
