- WHO adds Janssen vaccine to list of safe and effective emergency tools against COVID-19 (WHO)




2020-2021 Flu Season

Seasonal influenza activity in the United States remains lower than usual for this time of year. ILI activity levels may be impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and should be interpreted with caution.

- Brazil: monkeys die from yellow fever, two human cases in 2021 (ONT)
- Ebola outbreak in Guinea may be due to a survivor of the 2014-2016 West African Ebola outbreak (<u>STAT</u>)
- Legionnaires' Disease cluster reported in north New Jersey (NewsDesk)
- Malaysia: two additional human rabies fatalities (ONT)
- NIH awards grants to support bacteriophage therapy research (NIH)
- Study of mosquito protein could lead to treatments against life-threatening viruses (NIH)
