 - o Delaware is administering vaccine to any resident over the age of 16
 - o As of May 9, Delaware has administered 806,473 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine (330,718 are fully vaccinated (34.5%), and 427,192 (44.6%) have had at least one dose).
 - o Delaware is lifting capacity [restrictions](#) on May 21

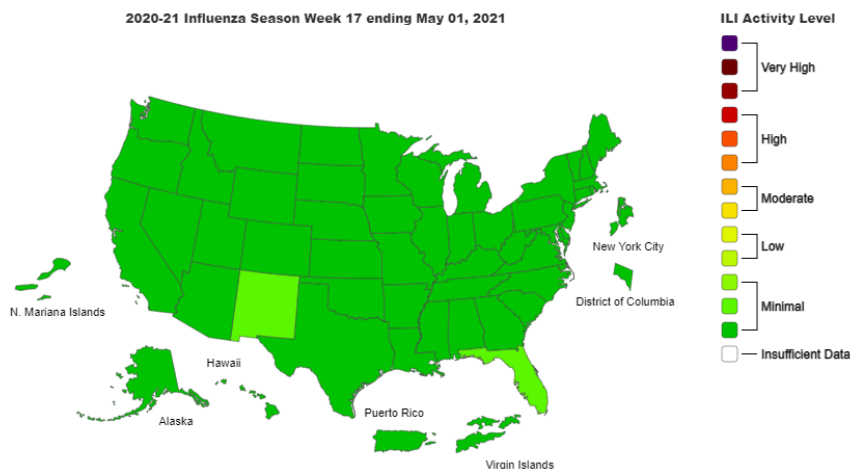


2020-2021 Flu Season

United States

Seasonal influenza activity in the United States remains lower than usual for this time of year. ILI activity levels may be impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and should be interpreted with caution.

There have been 21 laboratory confirmed cases of influenza in Delaware so far this season.
