 - o As of May 16, Delaware has administered 877,705 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine (367,356 are fully vaccinated (38.4%), and 459,018 (48.0%) have had at least one dose).
 - o Delaware has opened four standalone COVID-19 [vaccination clinics](#), which will serve for the next several months as an option for people to be vaccinated (with or without an appointment). Appointments can be made by calling 1-833-643-1715. Clinics will offer vaccines Monday through Friday from 8:30 – 11:30 am and 1:15 – 4:00 pm.

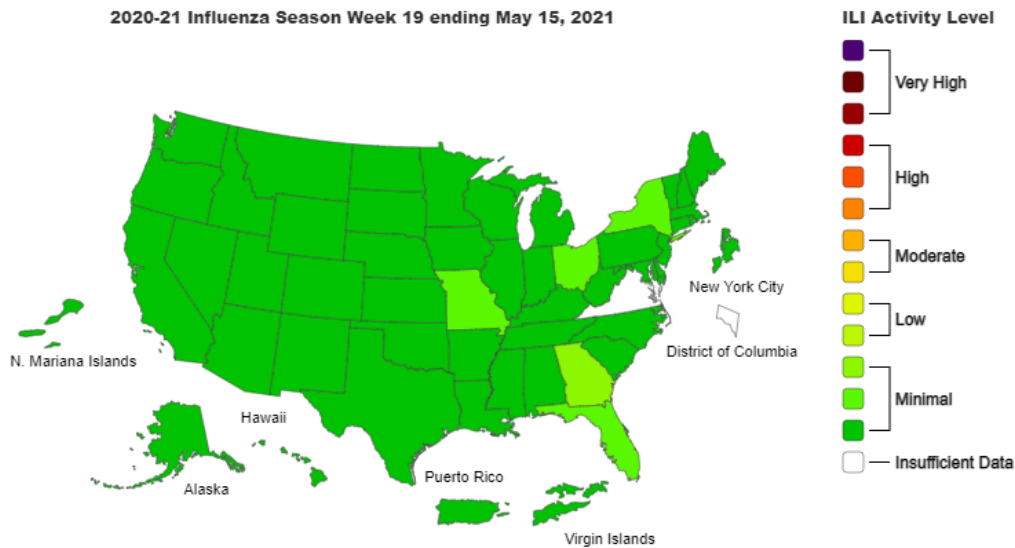


2020-2021 Flu Season
