- Delaware Specific COVID-Vaccine Information (de.gov/covidvaccine)
- Delaware Vaccine Release Tracker (<u>MyHealthyCommunity</u>)
  - Delaware is administering vaccine to any resident over the age of 16
  - As of May 2, Delaware has administered 759,686 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine (302,042 are fully vaccinated (31.6%), and 109,400 have had at least one dose).



#### **United States**

Seasonal influenza activity in the United States remains lower than usual for this time of year. ILI activity levels may be impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and should be interpreted with caution.

There have been 21 laboratory confirmed cases of influenza in Delaware so far this season.
