 - o As of May 2, Delaware has administered 759,686 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine (302,042 are fully vaccinated (31.6%), and 109,400 have had at least one dose).

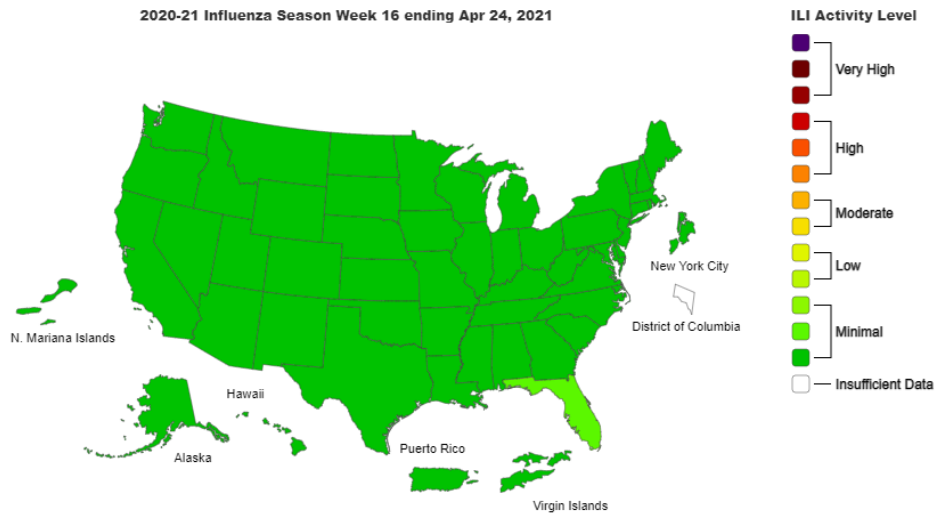


2020-2021 Flu Season

Seasonal influenza activity in the United States remains lower than usual for this time of year. ILI activity levels may be impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and should be interpreted with caution.
