Week 39: September 21-27, 2020

- New Events
- Ongoing Events
 - **Chad Chikungunya** (30,220 cases; 1 death; CFR 1.8%). The outbreak was declared in August, and the cumulative number of cases has

increased, with a declining daily trend. Most cases were reported from Abeche Health District.

- DRC Ebola Virus Disease (2020) (124 cases; 50 deaths; CFR 40.3%).
 Zero additional cases and zero new deaths have been reported since September 18. Twelve out of 18 heath zones and 40 out of 281 health areas in Equateur Province have reported at least one confirmed or probable case, and three health workers have contracted the disease.
- South Africa Coronavirus Disease (670,766 cases; 16,398 deaths; CFR 2.4%). A sustained decline in the daily number of cases has been seen since July, however the country continues to register the highest number of cases and deaths on the continent.
