- New Events
- Ongoing Events
 - DRC Ebola Virus Disease (2020) (109 cases; 47 deaths; CFR 43.1%). Nine additional cases and zero new deaths have been reported this week. Twelve out of 18 heath zones and 39 out of 281 health areas in Equateur Province have reported at least one confirmed or probable case, and three health workers have contracted the disease.
 - Ethiopia Cholera (14,728 cases; 257 deaths; CFR 1.7%). The current outbreak started in April 2020, and eventually affected 76 woredas from nine regions. There are 98 cholera treatment centers established across the country.
 - Kenya Coronavirus (36,157 cases; 622 deaths; CFR 1.7%). The outbreak continues to show a declining trend in new cases and deaths, and is still concentrated in Nairobi County, although all 47 counties have reported cases.
