- New Events
- Ongoing Events
 - **DRC – Ebola Virus Disease (2020)** (109 cases; 47 deaths; CFR 43.1%). Five additional cases and three new deaths have been reported this week. Eleven out of 18 health zones and 34 out of 281 health areas in Equateur Province have reported at least one confirmed or probable case.
 - **Ethiopia – Coronavirus Disease** (51,122 cases; 793 deaths; CFR 1.6%). Cases have been rising steadily since June, and number of new cases have surpassed 10,000 weekly in the past two weeks.
 - **South Sudan – Flooding**. More than 500,000 have been displaced and/or affected by the flooding in the Jonglei and Greater Pibor Administrative Area. The heavier than normal rainfall is expected to last through September.
